"Noa Charuvi's paintings convey a distinct sense of place where narratives of the present interrupt those of the past with urgency, sometimes even violence. Yet, her places encapsulate past and present not only as a rupture but also as an ongoing flow of coinciding contradictory forces – ruin and construction, anarchy and order. No matter if the painting depicts an interior of a room or an exterior of a construction site, it frequently portrays a place that is devoid of human figures but charged with the aftermath of human actions."

Artist Biography

Born in Israel and based in New York City, Charuvi holds an MFA from the School of Visual Arts and a BFA from the Bezalel Academy in Jerusalem. She was a 2018-19 recipient of The Pollock Krasner Foundation Grant.

Her work has been exhibited internationally, in venues such as The Bronx Museum of The Arts (New York), Haifa Museum of Art and Mishkan Museum of Art, Ein Harod (Israel). Recent one-person shows featuring Noa's work took place in H Gallery in Paris and Art100 in New York.

She's completed residencies at Art Omi, Yaddo and the Lower East Side Printshop and was a studio resident at the Elizabeth Foundation's Studio program from 2011-17.

Her paintings were featured in *Landscape Painting Now*, an anthology of contemporary painting published by D.A.P and Thames & Hudson. In 2019 Noa was a recipient of a travel grant from Asylum Arts and a studio grant from FST Studio Projects Fund.
